## 1. Kiyotaki park



This is Kitakyushu's first park. Here you can enjoy the waterfall of the Kiyotaki river mountain stream as well as the cherry blossoms and azalea flowers.

### Plants

Blooms from July to August.



**Orange Daylily**  
It is a wild Liliaceae mountain flower. It is otherwise known as the Hemerocallis Fulva and can be found near Kazagashira.

Yamazakura

Yamazakura are Japan's most popular kind of wild cherry blossoms. They bloom near the top of Mt. Kazashi.

**Japanese Wisteria**  
These are Leguminous plants. You can enjoy them throughout their blooming period as Wisteria can be found everywhere on the mountain.

Alunus firma

These were planted for the purposes of erosion control and after a flood disaster which had occurred there. Alunus firma are a type of Betulaceae.

### Wild Birds

Crested Honey Buzzard



These birds, which are a type of hawk, can be found around the middle of Eurasia. In Japanese they are called Hachikuma because they are similar in appearance to mountain hawks which are called Kumataka as they are both birds of prey. Furthermore, Hachikuma eat bees which are called Hachi in Japanese hence the name Hachikuma. From Mt. Kazashi, in the middle of September, you can see them in migration flight.
