Since the start of the Government Managed Yawata Steel Works in 1901, and the gathering of many factories centering on heavy industry, the Kitakyushu area developed as one of the four major industrial areas in Japan, propelling the industrial modernization and rapid economic growth of Japan. However, on the other hand, the rapid economic growth brought serious environmental pollution in the 1960s.
